

Tournament Water Ski Site

The Water Ski Club has been involved in the development and funding of Lake Hood.

All Tournament Water Ski Site equipment is owned by Water Ski Lake Hood Inc. including slalom and jump courses, docks, buildings and decks.

Water Ski Lake Hood aims ...

To promote waterskiing, and provide facilities for coaching and teaching members, and running water ski tournaments.

WSLH has homologated slalom and jump courses, and also a half course slalom. The club offers ski schools, water ski tournaments, and club night Thursdays.

WSLH is affiliated to the Canterbury and NZ Tournament Water Ski Associations. WSLH is responsible for the management of the Tournament area.

When club members are present the area becomes restricted to people using the ski course, others must leave the area while the ski lane is in use.

There are restrictions on the use of the Tournament Water Ski Site for safety reasons, and preservation of this site and equipment.

No weighted wakeboard boats ...

The banks and islands of this very narrow ski site are tapered to dissipate wave action and have already been re-graded to counter erosion effects of large wakes.

The ski jump is anchored by wire ropes to concrete bases. The jump is under great strain from boat wakes... In 2010 the base buckled and the jump has since been rebuilt by the club, a significant investment.

No jetboats, jetskis, ski biscuits ...

Bouys are for their intended skiing use only. They are easily dislodged and not easy or cheap to replace. They also have magnets attached for computerized boats.

The jump is for ski jumping only, it's surface is easily damaged.

No swimming, or dogs ...

Again a safety issue, we have had experience of swimmers and dogs among the bouys, in the middle of the boat path, and behind the jump... !
The boats are travelling at up to 58 k, and skiers are considerably faster.

The Lake Hood Tournament Water Ski Site is built and equipped to World standards, and offers some of the best skiing conditions in NZ.

With only one boat allowed at a time it is also one of the safest places to waterski. We are fortunate to have this wonderful ski site, and ask that members help ensure everyone respects the site and club equipment.
