Opening and Closing Ceremony thrills classic car rides, and police escort thru traffic to the Buddah nightclub in town

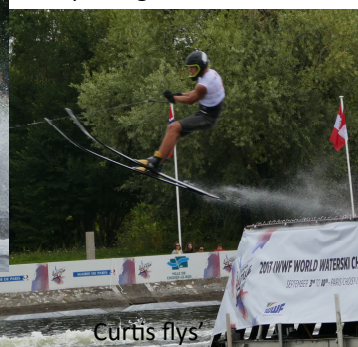
